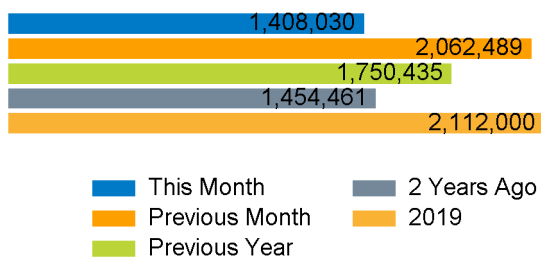
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 16,369,226 which is 15.6% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Aberdeen City Centre in month commencing 1 October 2023 was 1,408,030.

The busiest day in month commencing 1 October 2023 was Saturday 14 October with 66,254 visitors.

The peak hour of the month was 14:00 on Saturday 14 October 2023 with footfall of 6,175.

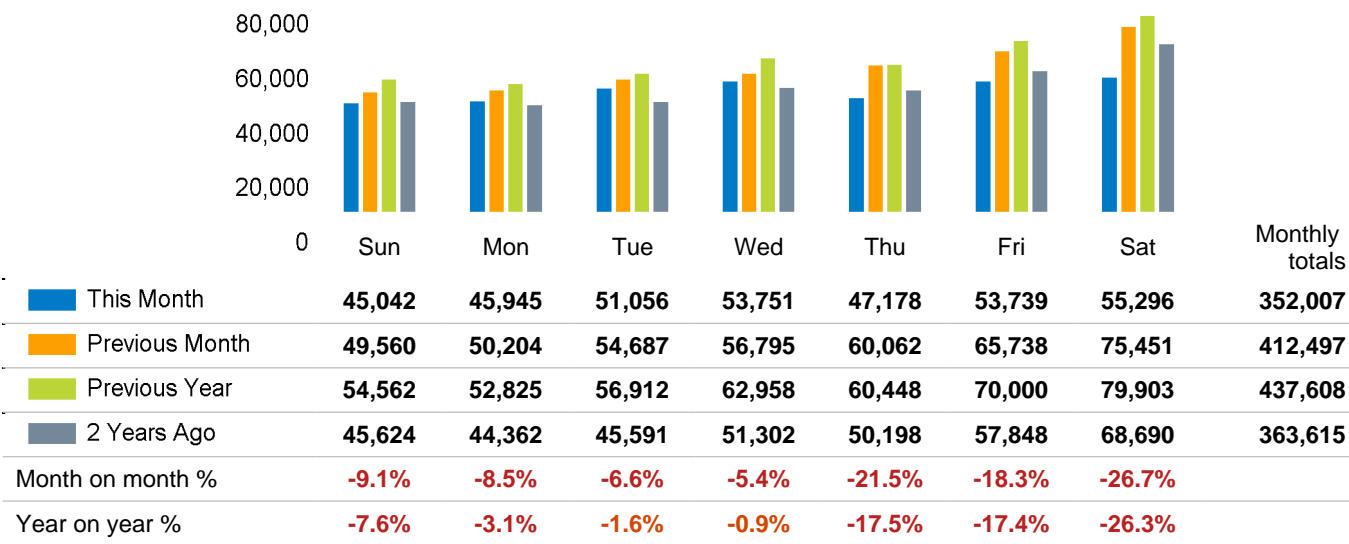

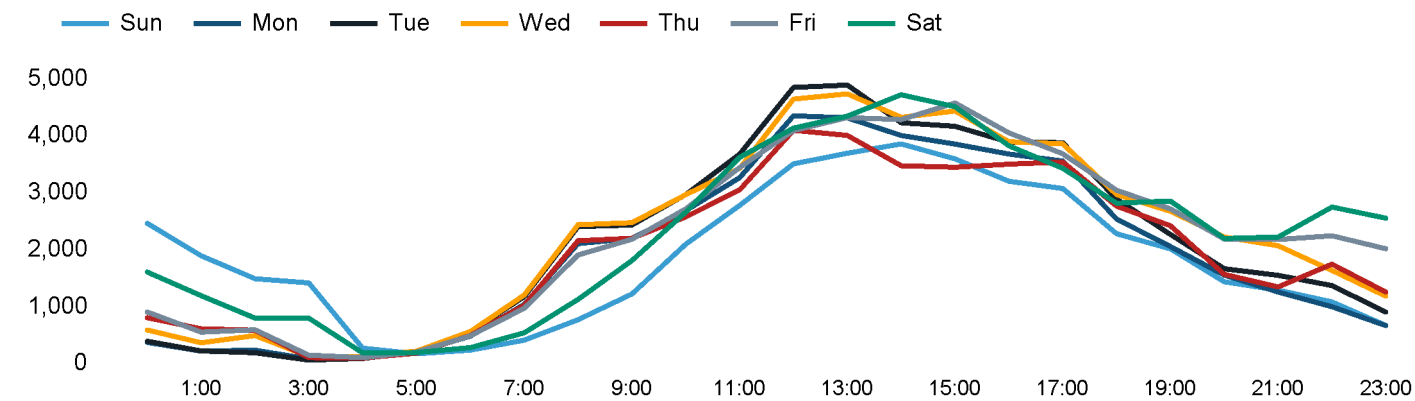
**Footfall Counts by day**

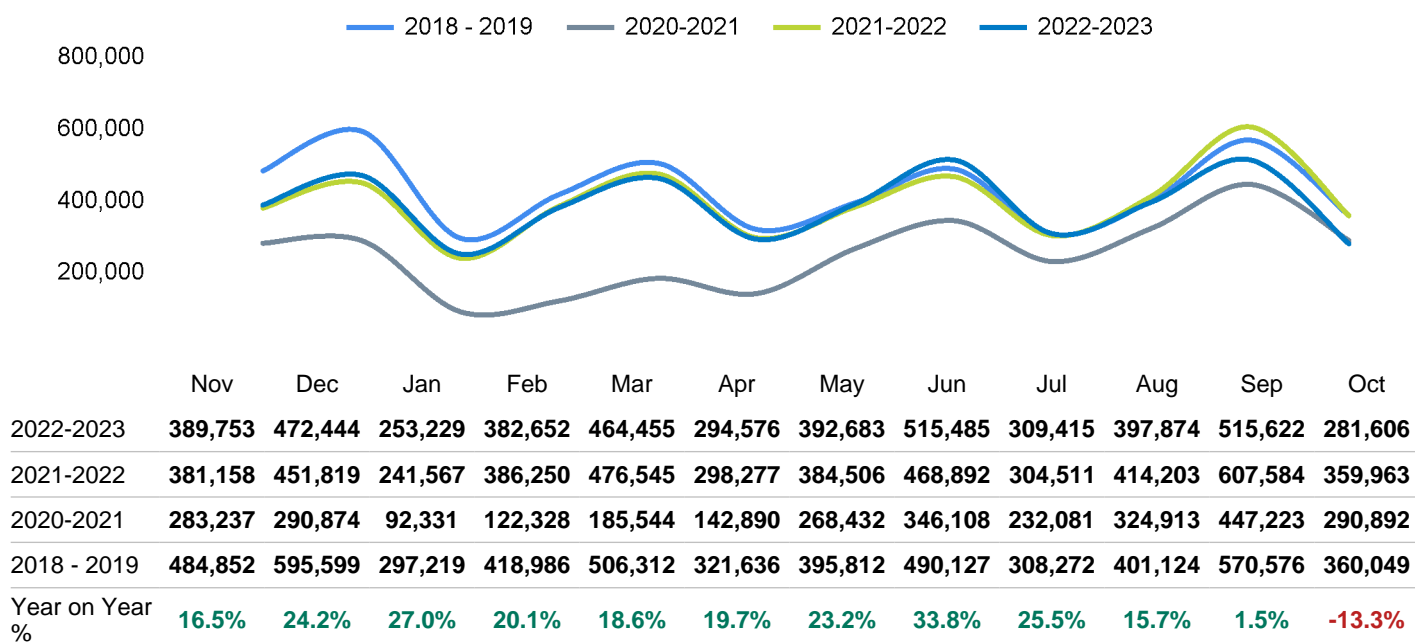
**Footfall Counts by hour**

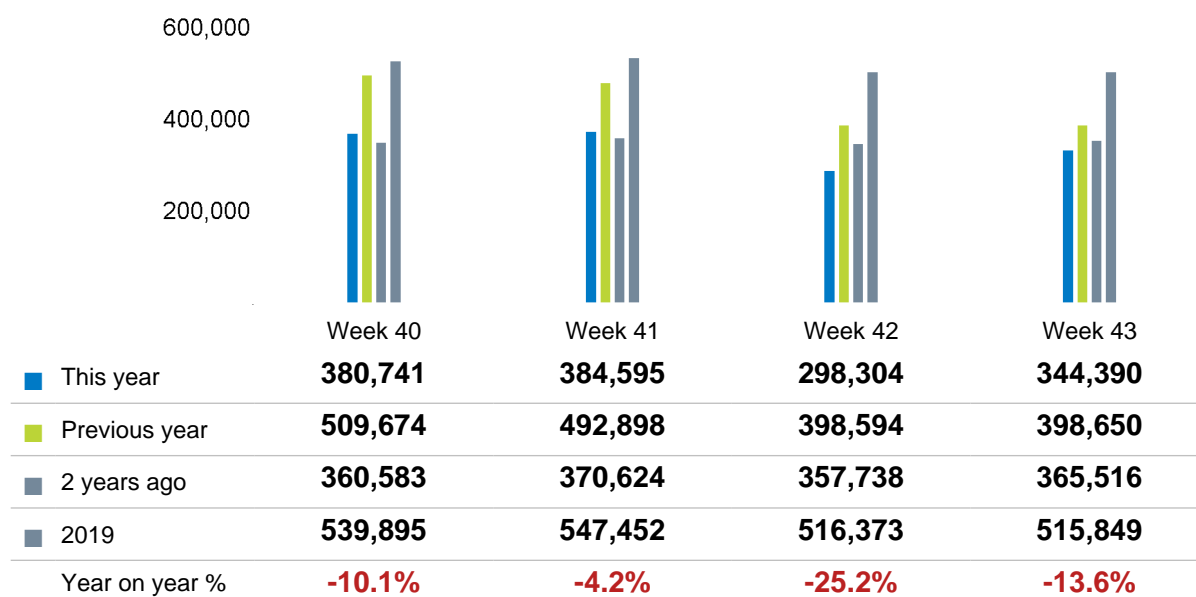

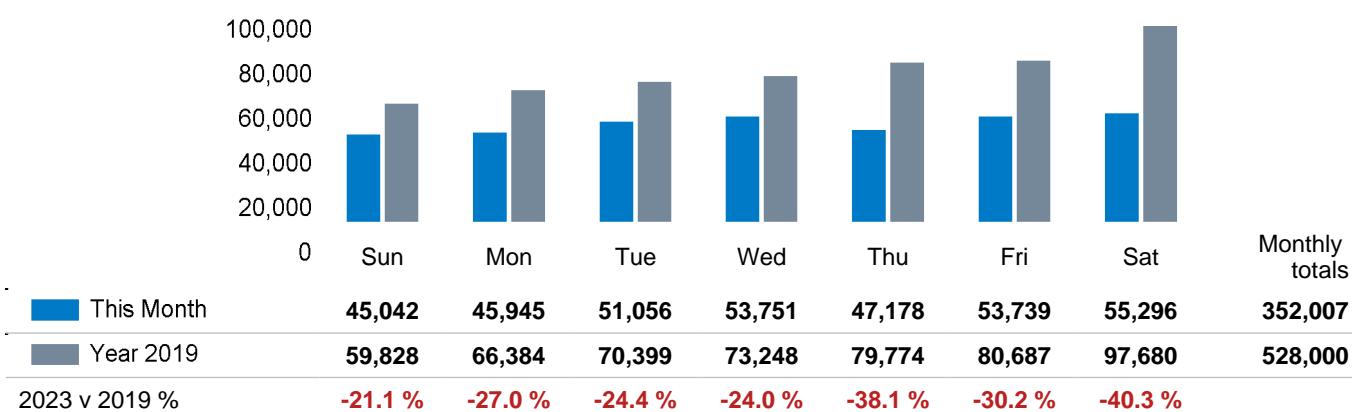

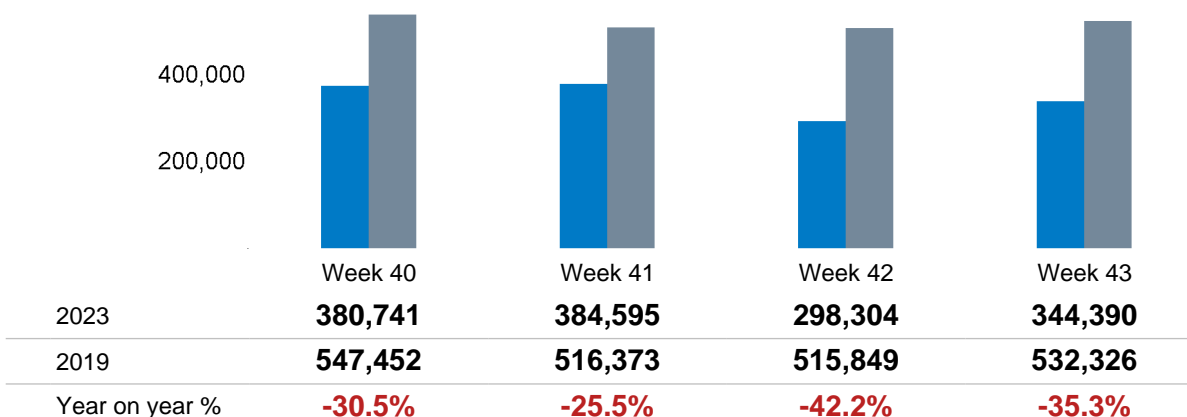
