The Aberdeen Christmas Market will be an outdoor festive market operating from Marischal College inside what has popularly become called the “Quadrangle”



The area will provide an attractive and safe space for local businesses and makers to sell their crafted and unique products and produce to customers who wish to shop local for their Christmas gifts and support our local Community. Applications for stall spaces at the Curated Christmas Market 2021 are now open for local arts, crafts and gourmet pre-packaged produce makers to showcase their wares at this exciting, high profile and busy festive market in the heart of Aberdeen.

Dates and operating times for the market

The Aberdeen Christmas Market will run Friday to Sunday on the following dates:

- Weekend 1, 19th November - 21st November 2021
- Weekend 2, 26th November - 28th November 2021
- Weekend 3, 3rd December – 5th December 2021
- Weekend 4, 10th December – 12th December 2021
- Weekend 5, 17th December – 19th December 2021

You will be able to set up 10am-4pm each Thursday in advance of the Fridays first day of trade.

Trading times are:

Friday 12pm-7pm, Saturday 11am-7pm, Sunday 11am-6pm.

We must also pre-warn you that access to the Quadrangle is from the rear of the building. This means bringing your products up approximately 39 stairs.

Event charge / donation to Charliehouse

Each 3 day weekend is priced at a minimum donation of £150 per stall. All stall space income will go directly to Charlie House.

There will be a comprehensive marketing and promotional campaign to promote the Christmas Market and all stallholders will be featured on our digital channels. Please be sure to bring plenty of stock to sell! This amount is payable direct to Charlie House in advance once your date and space has been confirmed and accepted. Charliehouse will issue an invoice and once paid, hire fees are non-refundable. Payments can be made via BACS or cheque; unfortunately we are unable to accept card payments.
